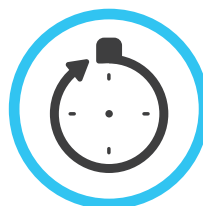

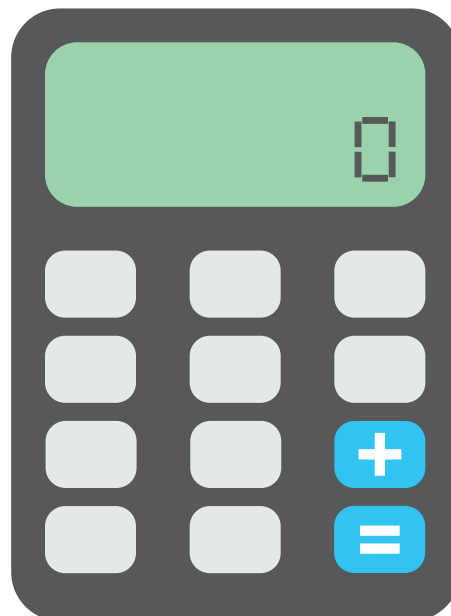
Healthcare economics example

For a 1,000 bedded hospital, there is likely to be up to 2,000 chairs, couches and recliners. Due to small upholstery damage, let's imagine 500 units need to be replaced per annum as a result of minor cosmetic damages presenting an infection control risk.

Average costs to replace:
£200,000 per annum

Average costs to repair:
£31,000 per annum

Savings estimate:
£169,000 per annum
